We serve youth ages 3-24, offering skill-building classes and performance ensembles for elementary, middle and high school students, along with a professional touring ensemble. We are located in San Francisco's Mission District and are based at Red Poppy Art House and Brava Theater. Our work includes on-site program and partnerships with SFUSD schools and other community-based organizations.

Founded in 2014, SFYT is rapidly expanding. We are seeking teaching artists who are interested in joining a team of dedicated theatre professionals who believe in youth development through the power of theatre and want to change the world through the arts.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities for Teaching Artists may include:

- Teaching students ranging from grades preK-12 in SFUSD sites or onsite at SFYT's resident theaters.
- Creating lesson plans for in-school programs
- Attending professional development trainings to enhance teaching and classroom management skills.
- Preparing performances and showcases for end of session.
- Meeting with partner teaching artists and/or classroom teachers to integrate curriculum with arts.
- Meeting with SFYT Executive and Program Directors to discuss programming.
- Directing or assistant directing full-scale productions.

Ideal qualifications may include:

- Two years teaching experience working with youth
- Strong arts experience in
 - Theatre
 - Dance
 - Visual Art
 - Photography
 - Music- Instrumental and Vocal
 - Spoken Word
- Spanish speaker or Chinese speaker a plus

This is an independent contractor position from 4-10 hours of teaching/week. Pay commensurate with experience and will compensate for prep time.
